'Sailing Cruises in Comfort' specialises in laidback, friendly, themed small cruises around the south-west coast of Turkey and the Greek islands aboard a fleet of stylish Turkish 'ketches', sleeping from six to 16 passengers. This year, themes include Greek and Turkish cookery, yoga and meditation, archaeology, painting, golfing, detox and photography. There are also a number of children's cruises, and monthly Greek Weeks, sailing through the islands, between May and October. The relaxed nature of these cruises means the captain is happy to discuss the route with you and together you can decide on the course for each day. About half of the passengers are travelling on their own so it's an excellent option for the solo traveller.

A highlight in this year's programme is the photography cruise (October 2-9), led by Jerjen Drenth, one of Holland's leading photographers, where the rapidly changing landscape is used to practise technique, composition and spatial awareness.
